We trust you had a good year so far.

You may also be aware that the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders (DSM) has recently been updated by version 5 (DSM 5), with some controversial changes and inclusions of what some may consider to be anything but a disorder.

One of these changes concerns grief and depression. The exclusion of bereavement that applied to people experiencing depressive symptoms lasting less than two months has been removed and replaced with annotations that guide clinical judgment. The criteria for Autism Spectrum disorders have been changed and now incorporate several diagnoses into one, thereby removing the ability to more specifically diagnose for example Aspergers Disorder.

These are some examples and how this will affect current clinical practice remains to be seen. We shall keep you informed as information filters through from greater minds than we can lay claim to. In the meantime, trust **your own clinical judgement** and when in doubt, simply refer to us for advice, and we will get back to you with our best efforts.

However we are in state of limbo in regard to various legislative requirements such as Workcover or Motor Vehicle Accident Authority, because in relation to psychological injuries the regulations state satisfaction of DSM-IV criteria. To get clarification of this dilemma we had written to the Premier who has replied that he has passed our request to the relevant Ministers. We wait with interest!

You will note the change in nomenclature from using Roman numerals to Arabic numbers. The reason is to make it easier to make version changes. Word on the street is that we are likely to get version 5.1 in the not too distant future!

Together we shall survive even DSM 5.

Saturday 9.00 am - 1.00 pm


In certain cases we will see people by special appointment outside of these hours.
